
BUS TIMETABLES





GETTING HERE IS EASIER THAN YOU THINK

The Bridgwater campus has approximately 24 buses arriving and leaving each day with connecting buses to transfer you to and from our Cannington campus.

Most buses that provide routes to BTC are public service buses and therefore timetables, routes and rules of carriage apply at all times. You need to ensure that your ticket provides the best value for money and could depend on the number of journeys you make each week and the location of your work placement.

You may be eligible for financial help towards the cost of bus travel through the 16-19 Bursary. Please contact Student Support for an application form on 01278 441233 or email studentsupport@btc.ac.uk.

You can purchase:

1. COUNTY TICKET

The annual Somerset County Ticket "Love the Bus"

Students living in Somerset can apply for the Somerset County ticket, which allows unlimited bus use within the County from 1 September to 31 August.

2. COLLEGE BUS PASS

The subsidised bus pass Offered by the College for students from Clevedon, Portishead, Weston, Castle Cary, Shepton Mallet, Wiveliscombe, Yeovil or Tiverton.

3. A daily, weekly or monthly ticket Bought directly from the bus operators.

TRAVEL CODE OF CONDUCT

All students are expected to abide by this travel code of conduct to avoid facing disciplinary action from the College or sanctions from bus companies.

- You are expected to act as an ambassador for the College at all times, whether travelling on public service buses or on College organised coaches or minibuses. You are therefore required to behave appropriately and with due consideration for all other passengers.
- It is College policy that all students wear seat beats at all times where these are available.
 You are expected to act responsibly, for your own safety and that of others.
- You must not distract the driver, make undue noise or throw any items, however small.
- Avoid any form of reckless behaviour and immediately report any incident to the driver or College staff.
- Breaking the law in relation to possession, taking or dealing with illegal substances, alcohol or solvents will result in a disciplinary procedure. This may result in your exclusion from College.
- Smoking of any sort is banned on College transport at all times, regardless of age.

- You are expected to refrain from behaving anti-socially. Verbal or physical abuse of the driver or other passengers is a breach of the Code of Conduct and will result in disciplinary measures.
- Bullying or harassment of others is never tolerated.
- Defacing or damaging any part of a vehicle used for College transport may lead to you paying for repair costs or criminal charges being brought against you.
- Fraudulent use of bus passes will result in the withdrawal of the pass. In addition, the bus company may prosecute and ban you from travelling on their services. The following are examples of fraudulent use of any bus pass:
- Lending your pass to someone else
- Changing the details on the pass
- Using the pass for journeys not covered by the pass


Please note that if you leave your bus pass at home you are liable to pay the full cost of travel. The College is not authorised to issue temporary vouchers or cash for travel.
