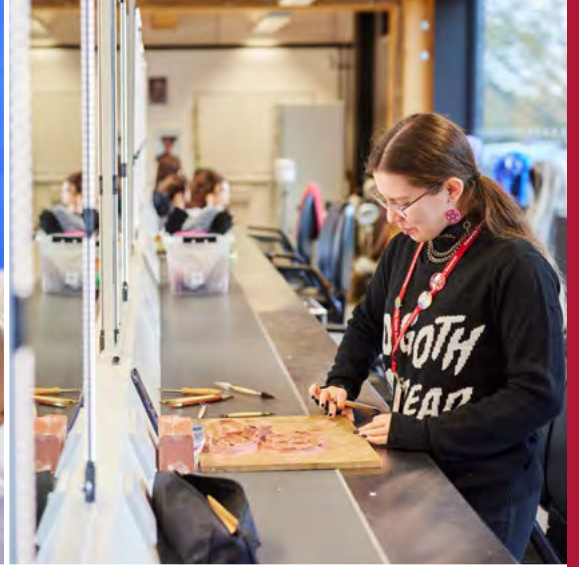

## Entry requirements

To study a higher education course, you generally need to have completed a full Level 3 qualification such as A Levels, T Levels, BTEC, an Apprenticeship or Access to HE Diploma, and Level 2 qualifications such as GCSEs or a recognised equivalent.

UCS is committed to providing equal opportunities for all applicants, and seeks to recognise an individual's potential to succeed and flourish.

As such, where appropriate, we will consider making a contextual offer to study with us to recognise life experience and potential, as well as previous academic achievement.

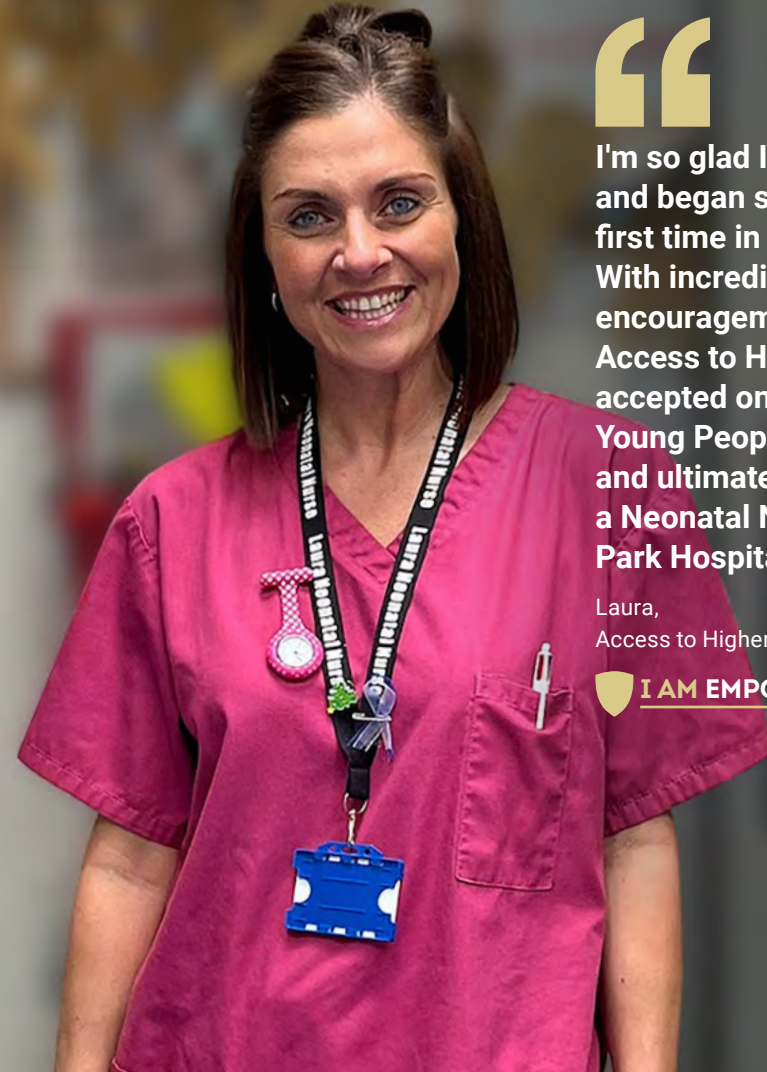
## Access to HE

An Access to Higher Education Diploma is designed to provide a route for learners aged 19 and over, who possess few formal qualifications, to progress to university-level study. It can lead to a wide range of career and Higher Education opportunities.

We currently offer two routes, each with progression opportunities linked to them:

- **Nursing, Midwifery and Healthcare**
- **Science.**

If you complete an Access to HE Diploma and then go on and complete a degree or other recognised higher education course, you will not have to repay the remaining loan for the Access to HE Diploma.

### Rail

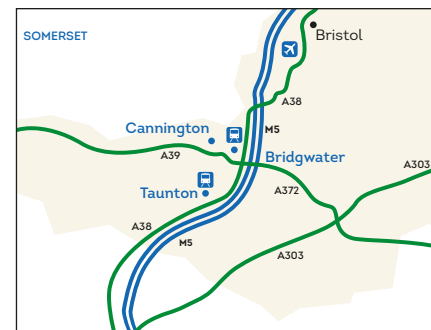
Our Taunton and Bridgwater campuses are easily accessible by train. Both towns are on the main line from Bristol to Exeter, and our campuses are within an easy walk or taxi ride of the station.

### Bus

We have bus stops on each of our campuses, served by local bus routes. A regular connection runs between the Bridgwater and Cannington campuses.
